- ❑ If you are carrying an I block – this does give you a “free” block in the regular day.

Math Program

The Grad requirement is a Math 11 or 12.

A Math 12 may be required for certain Post-Secondary Programs.

Foundations of Math 11 & 12

Generally, for students who are planning to apply to Bachelor of Arts Programs at the Post-Secondary level. (Anything not Science related.)

Precalculus 11 & 12

Generally, for students who are planning to apply to Bachelor of Science programs at the Post-Secondary level. (and most Business Programs)

Workplace Math 11

Works as a graduation credit

Post-secondary admission – Douglas College / UFV / some trade programs

Elective Courses

Remaining electives can be anything **BUT** – you should be looking at post-secondary entrance requirements for programs that may be of interest and filling in those requirements as your electives.

- ❑ A second language is not required for graduation – but a Language 12 course does count as an academic 12 for entry to university and it may also qualify as a degree requirement for the Faculty of Arts. Please check with the post-secondary program.
- ❑ A support class counts as one of these electives. You must have your support teacher sign your form to approve your support block.

Elective Choices



- ❑ Talk to peers that have taken the course, teachers, and/or Counsellors if you are having trouble making a decision.
- ❑ It is important to have at least 2 ALTERNATE COURSE REQUESTS – just in case a first-choice course is not offered due to low enrollment or there are not enough seats

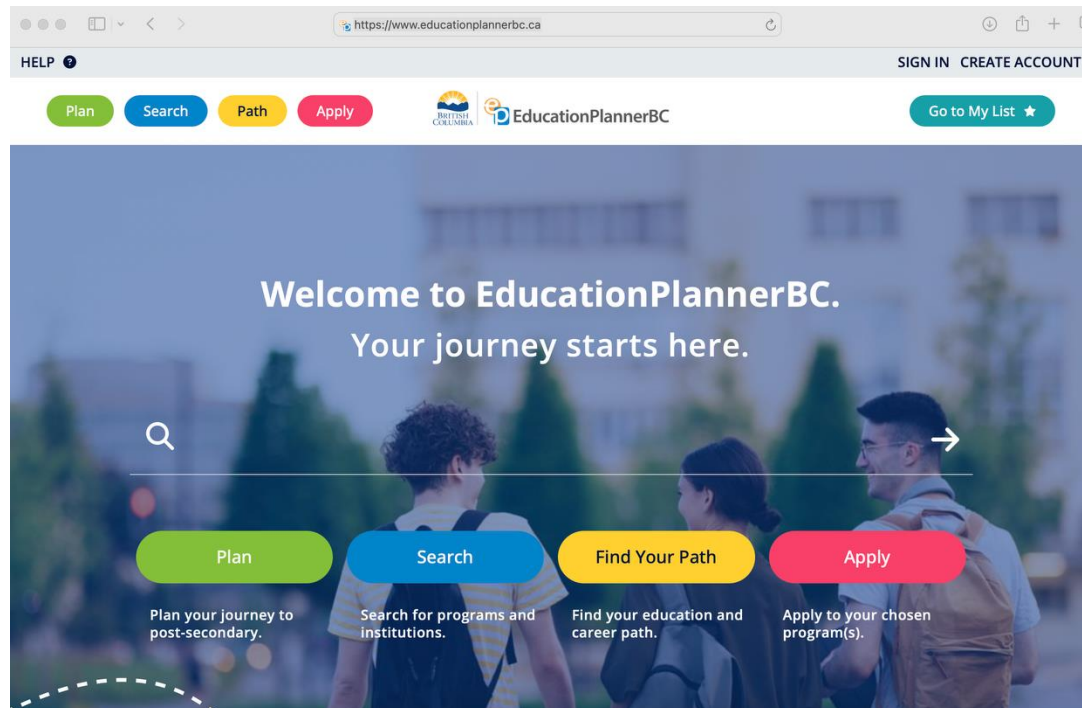
