Dear PMSS families:

As we move into the long weekend, I wanted to follow-up with some additional information not covered in my initial welcome back letter distributed last week.

On Thursday, September 1<sup>st</sup>, we welcomed our new Grade 8 class for their Orientation Day. These students, the future class of 2027, met with our leadership students, re-oriented themselves to the physical building, found their classes and got their lockers. The day culminated in a BBQ lunch served up by the school administration team. The school was a buzz of excitement as the almost 200 new students navigated the hallways and played ice-breaker games. It was such a positive day and we as a staff were so happy to have students back, interacting in such a seemingly normal pre-pandemic way; hopefully an indicator of more positive times to come.

Looking ahead to next week, as a reminder, Tuesday will be a *staggered* day with students coming by grade, receiving their schedules in the MPR and attending their Block A Homeroom class.

Schedules will also be available online with the reactivation of student and parent **MyClass accounts** taking place on Sept 7<sup>th</sup> (for students) and Sept 19<sup>th</sup> (for parents). Students are reminded to bring a lock if they would like a locker. Homeroom teachers will review start-up information and then dismiss students approximately 45 minutes later. Our regular schedule will start on Wednesday, September 7<sup>th</sup> at 8:30 a.m. in Block B. Cafeteria service will start-up in week two at “The Pitt Stop” in the MPR. Cafeteria lunch cards can be purchased over the portal or students can pay by cash at the counter. Until service has started, students are reminded to pack their lunches with them. For those new to high school, students are allowed to go home at lunch if they wish, though classes start up at 12:20 p.m. and we would like to ensure our students have returned and are ready to go and in their desks at the bell.

During the week of Sept 12-16<sup>th</sup>, we will be holding Grade assemblies during *Flex Time*. Starting with our Grade 8’s on Monday and finishing with our Grade 12’s on Friday, students will be introduced to the “who’s who” for staff, as well as review the pertinent information needed to ensure a successful start to the academic year. The course change process will also be discussed.

If your student has questions about some of their classes or find themselves in a class they may not have registered for, they are asked to hold off on seeing counsellors until *after* their grade assembly. Until then, students should attend all of the classes they are currently scheduled into.

The fall athletic season will be kicking off quickly with volleyball, boys’ soccer, cross country, etc. Students should listen to announcements for start-up information related to tryout dates, times and locations. With the return of school sports, I look forward to welcoming spectators
