
# VIRTUAL FRENCHTUTORING



#### How does it work?

- · The French tutoring program runs for eight weeks.


BonPatron is an online tool for writing in French that identifies spelling errors and common grammatical problems. BonPatron Pro offers several advantages over the free version:


- no advertising (ads help support the free version)






### SUPPORTING LISTENING COMPREHENSION
