For those students needing a little extra support, our Leadership students are hosting free Peer Tutoring sessions every Wednesday during Flex in the library. On Friday, November 8th, we observed Remembrance Day. Student-led assemblies acknowledged the courage and sacrifice of the countless Canadian men and women who have served for the cause of peace and freedom, many paying the ultimate price. Remembrance Day allows us all to take pause and reflect and remember the courage and sacrifice of so many.

Information related to ticket purchases and guest applications will be made available after Spring Break.

Looking ahead to December, our Term 1 Report Cards will be published on Thursday, December 12th and will be viewable for parents on MyClass. This will mark the first of three formal reports regarding student learning and progress. If you would like to discuss your student's academic progress, please connect with your student's teacher(s) directly or following that, with their grade level Counsellor and/or grade level Administrator. All teacher, counsellor, and administrative emails are listed on the PMSS website under the STAFF top tab. If you are unable to access your student's report card on MyClass, please email myclass@sd42.ca This portal is also how you can monitor and track your student's attendance. In the absence of the district attendance autodialer, this is the main window into your student's attendance patterns.

Finally, as a school, we now have Interac terminals in our cafeteria, student store, and main office. Lunch cards can still be purchased by parents via the Parent Portal, but we are very happy to have the interac option available to students at The Pitt Stop and at our school store.


