- All Grads and Guests attending Dry Grad need to have a **WAIVER FORM** completed. It is due back no later than Friday, May 8th.

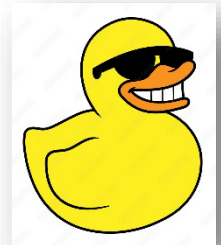
